TH 37 Senecal Road is 0.14 miles long and has 2 residential homes but the town plow and grader have trouble turning around due to the amount of vehicles in the yard. TH 11 Moran Road is 0.06 miles long this road has no turn around so the town vehicles have to pull in and back out onto Reservoir Road. If the board decides to discontinue these roads we will have to notify the affected property owners and hold a public hearing in October.**
- 7. Consider signing a resolution to add Lynn Craig’s name as an authorized signer on the Cemetery investment accounts.**
- 8. Consider a request from the church group who uses the town hall on Sundays. They would like to install a small projector mount on the pole where the stage curtains hang.**
