

Town of Orange
Trash Removal Policy

Article 1. Authority: Under the authority granted by the Town of Orange Selectboard we hereby adopt the following policy concerning Trash Removal

Article 2: Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to maintain a designation and a set of rules for Trash Removal within the Town of Orange.

Article 3: Application: This policy applies to all residents and nonresidents within the Town of Orange

Article 4: Objective: The principal objective of the Trash Removal Policy is to provide for a set of rules for residents to adhere to regarding excess trash on a residential property.

Article 5: Policy: The policy shall read as follows: The owner or occupant of any residential, agricultural or commercial property within The Town of Orange shall be responsible for securing an approved method of collection for rubbish generated on their premises. It shall be unlawful for any person to allow, cause or permit the dumping of rubbish upon any private or public lands within The Town of Orange. No owner or occupant of a residential, agricultural or commercial establishment shall permit the accumulation of rubbish upon any premises for a period in excess of 30 days. Approved methods shall be limited to arrangements for transport by a commercial hauler or transport and proper disposal of a person's own rubbish to a designated facility. If these guidelines are not met the following offenses will occur:

1st offense – will receive a registered letter from the Town Health Officer asking for trash to be removed within 30 days.

2nd offense – will be turned over to the Selectboard and subject to fines as deemed by the Town Health Officer(s).

Article 6: Effective Date: This policy shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Selectboard
