1. 6:00 - Call Meeting to Order: Chairperson Simpson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. 6:01 - Approve Minutes of May 29 and June 6:

May 29 -- The 8:15 item -- strike the name "Wilson made a motion" and replace with "Symonds made a motion". On a motion by Symonds, seconded by Wilson, the May 29, 2024 minutes were unanimously approved with the correction.

June 6 -- Strike a bottom "Notes" and replace with "Minutes". On a motion by Symonds, seconded by Wilson, the June 6, 2024 minutes were unanimously approved with the correction*.
3. 6:05 - Approve Agenda: On a motion by Wilson, seconded by Symonds, the board voted unanimously to approve the agenda.
4. 6:10 - Fireworks Permit: Permits were submitted by Dave Otterman (Riddel Pond Rd.) and Raymond Rossi (Precht Rd.) Wilson and the Fire Warden will check the Rossi location. On a motion by Symonds, seconded by Wilson, the board voted unanimously to approve both permits.
5. 6:25 - Road Commissioner Report:

Riddel Pond - Wilson stated he has received no response from either Ben or Jeff. He will catch up with them next week.

Town Clerk's Office - Wilson stated he will have Lajeunesse Construction and E.F. Wall look at the roof and the foundation of the building.

6. 6:45 - Grants Update: Lee Cattaneo reviewed the status on the following grants --

Riddle Pond Rd -- CVRPC is willing to help see if any grants are available for the Riddel Pond Road project.

Sidewalk Study for Orange Center -- A public hearing will be held in September or October to discuss alternatives.

Town Office/Town Hall -- An amended resolution for the Planning Grant needs to be done asap. This grant is for structural work for the Town Office and modifications for handicap accessibility at no cost to the town. Ginny Raboin advised that energy assessments have just been done to the Town Office, Town Hall, and Town Garage.
